

Program Management

A Comprehensive Generator Program Helps Prepare the City for Storm Events

June 1 marked the first day of hurricane season, a period that lasts until November 30. Louisiana's low lying land and subtropical climate makes it particularly susceptible to the affects of hurricanes and tropical storms and requires precautionary actions. Baton Rouge has experienced devastating storms in recent history, so what is being done to prepare?



City-Parish Preparation

As power outages are prevalent during storms, the City-Parish (C-P) has put in place a detailed generator emergency response plan that includes coordination with the SSO Program Management team, the maintenance of permanently installed generators, and the deployment of portable generators. Field teams are active throughout the duration of the emergency.

The C-P has also started work on a comprehensive generator installment project that includes the procurement and installation of standby generators at pump stations throughout the parish. The goal of the generators is to provide backup power should loss of power occur during a storm event. Additionally, the C-P is installing a Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition (SCADA) system that remotely controls and monitors the collection system which includes pump stations and treatment plants. The SCADA system will provide greater reliability to the collection system and allows for faster responses to abnormal and emergency conditions within the collection system.

Be Prepared: Plan Ahead

- Develop a family emergency plan identifying different types of emergencies, contacts, escape plans, safe areas in the home, and what to do in case of power outages and personal injuries.
- Create an emergency supply kit containing water, nonperishable food, clothing, blankets, medicines, extra car keys, money, battery powered radio, flashlight, spare batteries, and a list of family physicians.
- Create an emergency car kit to include battery powered flashlight and radio, booster cables, fire extinguished, and water. Check to make sure the car's spare tire is in good condition.
- Download apps related to storm preparedness, tracking, and updates to your phone in case a computer is not accessible.

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LOOKING AHEAD...

The following projects are expected to advertise for construction bids during 3rd quarter 2013. As projects are advertised for construction bid, they will be posted on the SSO Program calendar at www.brprojects.com.

South Boulevard–St. Joseph Street, Phase B Capacity Improvement Project (07-PS-BD-0048A): This project consists of approximately 1,400 LF, of new force main ranging from 24 to 30 in. diameter along River Rd and about 2,500 LF of new 36 in. diameter gravity sewer pipe along South Blvd.

Antioch Road–Chadsford Drive Comprehensive Rehabilitation Project (TBD): This project includes the rehabilitation of the sewer collection system in the area of George O'Neal St between Jones Creek Blvd and the parish boundary.

Government Street–South Acadian Thruway Capacity Improvement Project (09-GS-MS-0043): This project will upgrade about 9,800 LF of gravity main ranging from 12 to 27 in. in diameter near Government St between Foster St and Acadian Thwy.

Jones Creek Road/Tiger Bend Road Area Rehab Project (12-AR-MS-0038): North of I-10 and south of Old Hammond Rd, this project involves physically inspecting pipes and manholes to determine and correct defects in the system.

Plank Road Pump Station Improvements (11-PM-MS-0024): Located centrally on the parish's western border, this project involves replacing 9 pump stations.

O'Neal Lane Pipeline Improvements-Group B (10-FM-MS-008B): Located in the southeastern area of the parish, this project involves replacing and constructing over 1,000 LF of 18 in. diameter gravity main and 27,000 LF of force main ranging from 6 to 36 in. in diameter.

O'Neal Lane Pump Station Improvements Group A (10-PS-MS-0050): This project will upgrade 17 pump stations to work in conjunction with force main upgrades in the southern portion of East Baton Rouge parish.

O'Neal Lane Pump Station Improvements-Group B (10-PS-MS-0051): This project, located along the southeastern border of the parish, involves replacing 27 pump stations, including converting BPS 889 from an in-line booster station to a wet well pump station.

Scenic Highway-Spanish Town Road: Phase 1 (TBD): Located north of I-10 and south of Hollywood St, this rehab project will consist of physically inspecting pipes and manholes to determine and correct defects in the system.

Interstate 110-Hollywood Street (TBD): This rehab project will consist of physically inspecting pipes and manholes to determine and correct defects in the system in the area north of Winbourne St.
