# 2010 Year In Review



Community leaders and small and disadvantaged business owners attended a seminar in March 2010 sponsored by the Mayor-President's office to encourage and promote local businesses.

# 2010 Program Highlights

- 71 active projects valued at \$947 million
  - » 11 projects complete with a construction value of \$42 million
  - » 30 projects under construction with a construction value of \$447 million
  - » 30 projects under design with a Progam Delivery Plan (PDP) construction value of \$447 million
- More than 170 different firms participating on projects

Phase 1 Wet Weather Capacity
Improvement project at the South
WWTP started in September 2010.
During periods of heavy rain, four
covered storage tanks that are being
installed will hold rainwater mixed with
sewage and release its flow gradually
so as to not overwhelm the plant. By
capturing and storing the excess flow,
sewer backups in neighborhoods and
overflows will be reduced.

#### **Coordination and Preparedness Benefits the Community**

- Conducted construction sequencing analysis to ensure intra-program project coordination that resulted in the consolidation/combining of several projects
- Coordinated with DPW projects and the Green Light Program to improve effectiveness and reduce construction-related disruptions to residents
- Initiated the emergency generators project

#### **Communication with the Community**

- Launched construction communication outreach program
- Coordinated closely with construction managers
- Provided Project Information Officers to respond to residents' questions and issues
- Initiated a construction hotline
- Coordinated with the City-Parish to track and follow up on residents' calls




#### **Supporting Local Disadvantaged Business Enterprises (DBEs)**

# **Excellence in Program Management**

- General Program Management including program controls (scheduling and cost control), document control, quality assurance, communication, outreach, health and safety, and financial management
- Design Management including engineering management, land acquisition (appraisal, inspection, titling, surveying, and negotiation), GIS, CCTV physical inspections, hydraulic investigations, permitting, archeological assessment, and hydraulic evaluation oversight
- Construction Management: Construction and contractor management, oversight of permitting and stormwater pollution prevention plans, and construction field administration

# Projects Expected to Advertise for Construction

The following projects are expected to advertise for construction bids in 1Q 2011:

- Multiple Pump Stations Jefferson Highway Park Forest Drive Capacity Improvement Project
- Silverleaf Road Ford Street Rehabilitation Project
- Perkins/Old Perkins Area Booster PS514 Capacity Improvement Project
- Bluebonnett Blvd Jefferson Highway Phase I Rehabilitation Project

# Projects Expected to Advertise for Engineering Design

SGC-C-0001 (Florida Boulevard PS Projects) – Anticipated 1Q 2011. Estimated Construction Cost - \$15,000,000. This project consists of replacing eight pump stations (PSs) and installing one new PS with future peak wet weather flows ranging from 800 to 23,000 gpm.

SGL-C-0003 (Highland Road Pipeline Projects) – Anticipated 1Q 2011. Estimated Construction Cost - \$15,000,000. This project consists of approximately 39,700 linear feet (If) of gravity sanitary sewer pipeline upgrades ranging in diameter from 15 to 42 inches and approximately 11,040 lf of new and upgraded forcemain sewer ranging in diameter from 10 to 24 inches.

SGU-C-0003 (Sherwood Forest Boulevard - Goodwood Boulevard Pipeline Projects) - Anticipated 1Q 2011. Estimated Construction Cost - \$10,200,000. This project consists of replacing approximately 26,940 lf of gravity sanitary sewer pipeline with 10- to 36-inch diameter pipeline and replacing 310 lf of 10-inch forcemain.
