

Program Management



May was a very busy month on the Baton Rouge Sanitary Sewer Overflow (SSO) Program! With more than 300 companies working on 88 active projects, the program continued to provide local businesses with opportunities, assist East Baton Rouge Parish in complying with a federal consent decree, and prepare the Parish for future growth by implementing important infrastructure improvements.

As community partners, preparing for natural disasters and encouraging readiness is priority for the SSO Program team. For instance, team members assisted the Department of Public Works in preparing for possible impacts related to rising Mississippi River levels, and are working with the Parish to improve community disaster readiness. With the hurricane season upon us once again, the SSO Program team is encouraging the East Baton Rouge Parish community and all program partners to become Red Stick Ready and to plan, educate, and remain aware of weather conditions.

The SSO Program is partnering with the Mayor-President's Office and the Department of Public Works to improve the community's preparedness by participating in the Red Stick Ready Program.

East Baton Rouge Parish is a national leader in emergency readiness. Under the leadership of Mayor-President Melvin L. "Kip" Holden and the Mayor's Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness, the Parish has developed the Red Stick Ready program to provide information to residents to help them prepare for, respond to, and recover from any and all emergency situations.

This readiness campaign has been nationally recognized and contributed to the Parish achieving the designation of a Storm Ready Community by the National Weather Service. The Mayor's Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness has also achieved the highest national certification from the Emergency Management Accreditation Program.

With the beginning of hurricane season on June 1 and another summer of sweltering heat, we encourage you to contact the Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness and prepare for an emergency

by creating an emergency plan, preparing disaster supply kits for your home and auto, learning the meanings of watch, warning, and protective action recommendations, and participating in the buddy system aiding elderly or infirmed neighbors and family. Preplanning for an emergency can reduce the possibility of personal injury, loss of life, and damage to property.

The SSO Program is improving the City-Parish's ability to manage storm events by:

- Adding 122 million gallons of storage capacity during heavy rain events
- Installing emergency generators at all Parish pump stations and two treatment plants
- Inspecting and repairing or replacing 1,042 miles of sewer pipeline
- Upgrading more than 66 miles of gravity sewer, 127 miles of forcemain, and 147 pump stations

- 1. Elm Grove Garden Road Harding Blvd: This rehabilitation project involves rehabilitating approximately 199,500 linear feet of gravity main and 839 manholes.
- Scotland Avenue Progress Road: This rehabilitation project involves inspecting and rehabilitating, as needed, approximately 208,000 linear feet of forcemain and 300 manholes.
- Group Project 2 Small Pump Stations: This capacity improvement project involves replacing seven pump stations that will work in conjunction with the forcemain upgrades in other South Forced Lower Basin projects.
- 4. Oak Villa Blvd Choctaw Street: This rehabilitation project involves inspecting and rehabilitating, as needed, approximately 245,000 linear feet of forcemain and 990 manholes.
- 5. **Highland Road Buchanan Street:** This capacity improvement project involves upgrading approximately 4,465 linear feet of forcemain and 8,390 linear feet of gravity main.
- **6.** Foster Drive Government Street (Phase A): This rehabilitation project involves replacing and rehabilitating 629 manholes and improvements to 80,600 linear feet of gravity main.
- 7. Nicholson Dr Highland Rd Perkins Rd (Phase A): This capacity project involves upgrades to approximately 8,400 linear feet of forcemain, 3,400 linear feet of gravity main and the rehabilitation/replacement of 20 manholes.
- 8. Citiplace/Essen Area PS119 and Forcemain Improvements: This capacity project involves replacing one pump station and upgrading approximately 8,100 linear feet of forcemain.
- South Blvd-St. Joseph St/25th St N. Acadian Thruway: This capacity improvement project involves upgrading approximately 18,360 linear feet of forcemain and 3,000 linear feet of gravity main.
- **10.** Foster Drive Government Street (Phase B): This rehabilitation project involves upgrading approximately 78,700 linear feet of gravity main.

- 11. Capitol Lake Dr Gayosa St/25th St N. Acadian Thruway: This capacity improvement project involves upgrading approximately 19,320 linear feet of forcemain and 19,150 linear feet of gravity main.
- Downtown Area Pump Station Improvements: This
 capacity project involves upgrading three pump
 stations.
- **13. Bluebonnet Blvd Jefferson Hwy Phase 1:** This rehabilitation project involves rehabilitating approximately 54,200 linear feet of gravity main.
- **14. Kenilworth Blvd Boone Drive:** This rehabilitation project involves rehabilitating approximately 72,000 linear feet of gravity main and 1,159 manholes.
- **15. Sharp Road Florida Blvd:** This rehabilitation project involves rehabilitating approximately 274,475 linear feet of gravity main and 1,154 manholes.
- **16. Bluebonnet Blvd Jefferson Hwy Phase 2:** This rehabilitation project involves rehabilitating approximately 63,100 linear feet of gravity main.
- **17. Silverleaf Road Ford Street:** This rehabilitation project involves implementing upgrades to 115,200 linear feet of gravity main.
- **18.** Multiple PS Jefferson Hwy Park Forest Drive: This capacity project involves upgrading six pump stations
- 19. Brookstown Road Evangeline Street (Phase 2): Phase 2 of this rehabilitation project involves rehabilitating approximately 84,000 linear feet of gravity main and 1,075 manholes.
- 20. Brookstown Road Evangeline Street (Phase 1): This rehabilitation project involves rehabilitating approximately 161,000 linear feet of gravity main and 1,150 manholes.
- Highland Road Burbank Drive: This capacity project involves upgrading approximately 39,400 linear feet of forcemain.













- **22. Zachary Area Transmission Network (Phase 4):**Phase 4 of this capacity project will upgrade approximately 42,500 linear feet of forcemain.
- 23. Group Project 1A (Veterans Parkway Gravity Mains):
 This capacity project involves upgrading approximately 46,000 linear feet of gravity main.
- **24. Choctaw Storage and PS Facility:** This WWTP project involves replacing three pump stations and implementing improvements to approximately 25,000 linear feet of forcemain.
- **25. SWWTP Wet Weather Improvements (Phase 1):** Phase 1 will provide wet weather storage, influent pumping, and preliminary treatment at the SWWTP.
- 26. Central Consolidation PS42 Forcemain Phase A: This capacity project involves upgrading one pump station and approximately 32,000 linear feet of forcemain.
- 27. Perkins/Old Perkins Area Booster PS 514 Improvements:
 This capacity improvement project involves upgrades to one booster pump station.
- **28. Zachary Area Transmission Network (Phase 1):** Phase 1 will involve upgrading three pump stations.
- **29. Zachary Area Transmission Network (Phase 3):** Phase 3 of this capacity project will improve approximately 27,000 linear feet of forcemain.
- Staring Lane Forcemain (Phase 2 Highland to Perkins): This capacity project involves upgrading approximately 12,363 linear feet of forcemain.
- **31. Emergency Generators Purchasing:** This project involves purchasing generators at each of the pump stations in East Baton Rouge Parish to ensure continuity of service during power failures.
- **32.** Emergency Generators Installation: This project involves installing generators at each of the pump stations in East Baton Rouge Parish to ensure continuity of service during power failures.
