Complex Baton Rouge Sewer Program Projects Benefit from Construction Management Experience

August 2011 was a busy month on the Sanitary Sewer Overflow (SSO) program. Four additional projects were advertised for construction bids and 94 projects were in some phase of design, construction, or completion. With the onset of the third quarter, planning for 2012 projects and SSO Program activities were also initiated this month and will culminate in the coming months with the annual update of the Program Delivery Plan, the primary SSO Program planning document. This planning process is a collaborative effort with Office of the Mayor-President, the Department of Public Works, and the SSO Program Management Team.

#### **Purpose**

The purpose of the Sanitary Sewer Overflow (SSO) Control and Wastewater Facilities Program is to address existing Consent Decree issues that require conducting improvements to sewer infrastructure and to also lay the foundation for Baton Rouge's future growth.

- Develop rehabilitation based SSO Program strategy
- Implement program within Consent Decree deadline
- Meet and exceed stakeholder expectations
- Minimize disruption to the public
- Implement a cost-effective and affordable program

## In the Spotlight...

The SSO Program Improves Sewer Infrastructure in the Cities of Baker and Zachary

SSO Program projects are improving the quality of life for residents throughout East Baton Rouge Parish. During rain events, the cities of Baker and Zachary experience high levels of rainwater inflow and infiltration and therefore require sewer system improvements. For this reason, the SSO Program is implementing three rehabilitation and capacity improvement projects in the area. In addition, generators will be installed to provide power during electrical outages at all of the pump stations operated by the City-Parish in the area.

#### **Repairing Existing Pipes to Improve Sewer System Performance**

SSO Program projects in Baker and Zachary involve inspecting, cleaning, and removing obstructions in sewer mains and repairing any cracks in the system to reduce the likelihood of infiltration. Where possible, construction methods such as trenchless technology that minimize above-ground disruption are used. Two examples of projects that will improve the sewer system in Baker and Zachary, are the Brookstown Road – Evangeline Street project, which is valued at \$16 million, and the Silverleaf Road – Ford Street project, which is valued at \$8 million.

#### Capacity Improvement Projects Provide a Foundation for Growth

The \$57.5 million Zachary Area Transmission Network Improvement Project is the

largest capacity improvements project in the SSO Program. The project is being constructed in four phases and includes the addition of three new pump stations, 20 miles of pipe, and 20 million gallons of storage. This project involves routing sewer flows from Zachary directly to the North Wastewater Treatment Plant; instead of its current route through Baker, freeing up capacity to the city in lieu of upsizing pipes.

On August 23, 2011, the SSO Program presented a status of Sanitary Sewer Overflow (SSO) Projects to Mayor Rideau and the City Council members of Baker. #### Projects Recently Advertised for Construction Bids

The following projects advertised for construction bids in August 2011:

**Central Consolidation Pump Stations Capacity Improvement Project**. Project includes construction of 9 pump stations (2,3,4,5,6,7,10,91, and Southdowns), odor control, site work, yard piping, and valves. Bids due 9/22/11 at 2:00 p.m.

**South Wastewater Treatment Plant Wet Weather Improvements Phase 2 Project.** The South WWTP Phase 2 project involves wet weather improvements within the treatment process.
